Day 1 Akeri Hope Pre & Primary School is located in the Western District and is the newest ELCT Diocese of Meru school. Akeri Hope was first registered as Preprimary in 2016 with support from St. John's in Brookfield. One year later in 2017, it was fully registered as a Pre & Primary school. Currently the school has 309 students in Preprimary through Standard Seven: 95 Preprimary students and 214 Primary students. Akeri Hope has 25 total staff members, 17 teaching and 8 non-teaching staff.



Day 2 Akeri Hope Pre & Primary School. Mr. Gadiel Jeremia Mbise was recently appointed the Head Teacher, and Pastor Franaely Joshua Issangya is the School Director. The school is proud of being a Christian school where Christian morals are imparted to each child. Akeri Hope uses English for instruction which is contrary to public primary schools where Kiswahili is used. Students have demonstrated remarkable performance on the national examinations. When they attend secondary schools they will be more proficient with the English language which is compulsory at the secondary level.



Day 3 Akeri Hope Pre & Primary school motto is "Education for a Better Tomorrow." The annual school fee is \$257 Preprimary and \$316 for the Primary level. Regardless of the parents' economic status, Akeri still feels that the school needs each child to achieve his/her dream. "We believe that supporting one child is supporting the whole world."







Day 4: Akeri Hope Pre & Primary School

Currently the school is experiencing scarcity of tables and chairs and textbooks for the students. The school has no computers to be used by teachers and students in the teaching and learning process. The school needs two school buses since many students live far away from school. The school needs additional classrooms for the growing number of preprimary students to maintain the ratio of 25 pupils in one classroom.
