- > The school opened in January 2014 with the first two buildings dedicated that summer.
- Enrollment grew adding a grade level each year. Every year, as a new class is added, both the size of the school and the need for sponsors grow.
- Additional classroom buildings were constructed in 2015
- Current enrollment is 100 Pre-primary and 300 Primary students

Why - a strong emphasis on education is the key to fighting poverty.

- Impact Traditionally, primary schools are taught in Swahili and have an average classroom of 80 students. Secondary schools are only taught in English which limits the number of students who can further their educations.
- Future Angaza offers faith-based learning taught in English, allowing the opportunity for a child to continue their education.
